God's Evaluation of Man

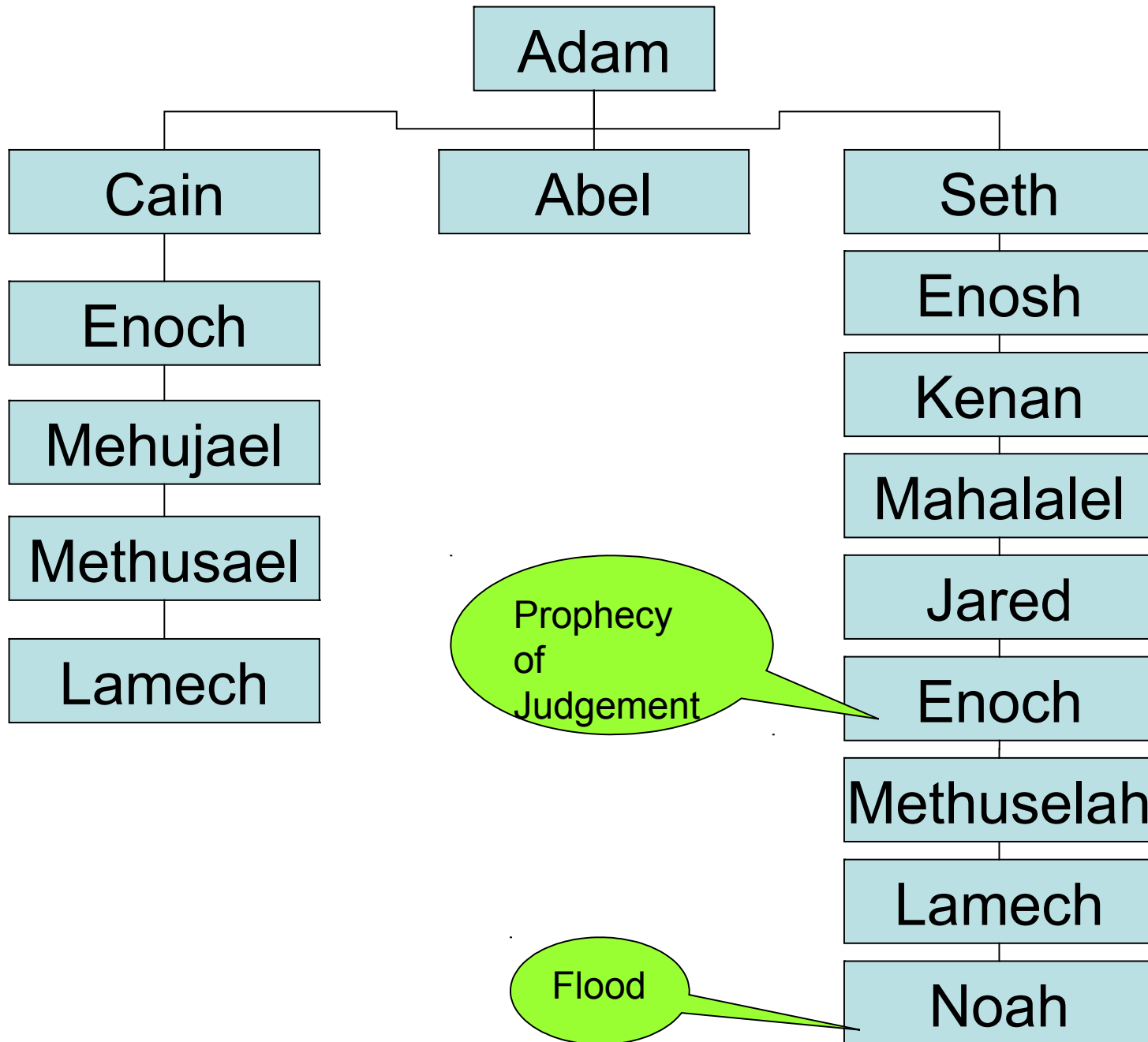
- Strife between Man / God (6v3)
- Wickedness great (6v5)
- Every imagination of the thoughts of his heart only evil, continually (6v5)
- Repentance at making man
- God grieved at the heart
- Man to be destroyed from the face of the earth
- Earth corrupt before God (6v11)
- Earth filled with violence (6v11)
- Flesh had corrupted God's way on earth (6v12)
- Imagination of mans heart is evil from his youth
- Ungodly (2 Peter2 v5)

- Just (6v9)
- Perfect in his generation (6v9)
- Walked with God (6v9)
- God establishes covenant with Noah (6v18)
- Righteous in his generation (7v1)
- Blessed (9v1)
- Condemned the world (Heb 11v7)
- Was a preacher of righteousness (2 Peter 2 v5)

Lessons for us

- When God says it will happen: it **will** happen.
- Any “apparent delay” that we see is God being longsuffering with mankind.
- We need to be like Noah and not like the world in his day / our day.
- We need to lift our heads up from the day-to-day and look for something more important about to happen.
- Hope of salvation through the same means as Noah; commitment and water
